### Swimming Program

Notes for our school's annual swimming program, commencing Monday 29<sup>th</sup> of April went home with last week's newsletter. The program will be held on five consecutive days at the Gisborne Aquatic Centre, and will be provided by qualified instructors. The cost of the program, including bus, pool entry and instructors, is \$90.00 per student. Please note that if you are eligible for Camps, Swimming, Excursions Funding (CSEF), the swimming cost will be covered by this allowance. If you are unsure, see Jeanette in the office on Tuesday. While the school is unable to cover the cost of non-paying families, we are always happy to support families to pay off more expensive camps or excursions in installments. For your child to attend, payment must be made OR an alternative financial plan made prior to the excursion.
