We have rebooked our excursion to see Frozen on the 1st of December at Her Majesty's Theatre which is something wonderful to look forward to.

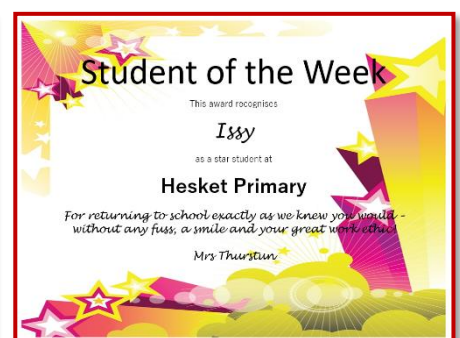
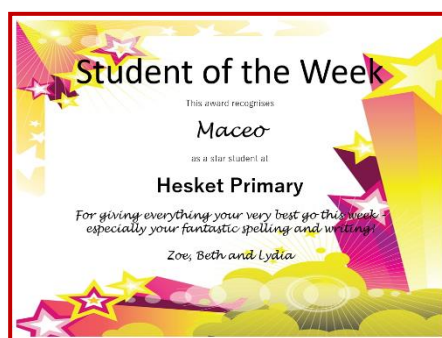
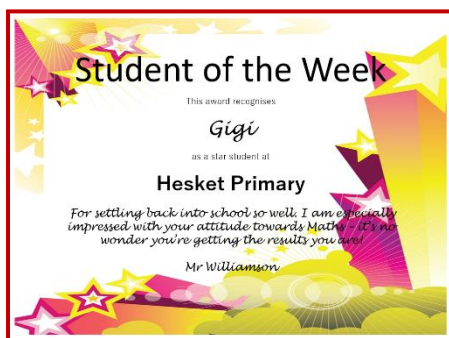
We aim to take our Grade 5/6 students away on a 'day camp' within the next few weeks; an opportunity they have missed out on over the last few years.

Vaccinations for Visitors and Volunteers

As we hopefully lead into a more 'Covid Normal' school setting, there are some important policies that the school must adhere to. Schools must collect, record and hold vaccination information for all volunteers working on school sites who will or may be in close proximity to children, students or staff.

All volunteers working on school sites must provide vaccination information. If unable to provide evidence of vaccination, they are not able to be onsite.

Schools must take reasonable steps to prevent an unvaccinated volunteer or visitor working on school sites from attending the school to perform work, unless an exception applies. If you would like to forward a copy of your
